Schiötz The weight marked 5.5 **always remains on the plunger**; the other weights must be added supplementarily to the 5.5 weight.

The average normal tension is 6 to 21 mm Hg.

Accuracy is most dependable with scale readings larger than 5.

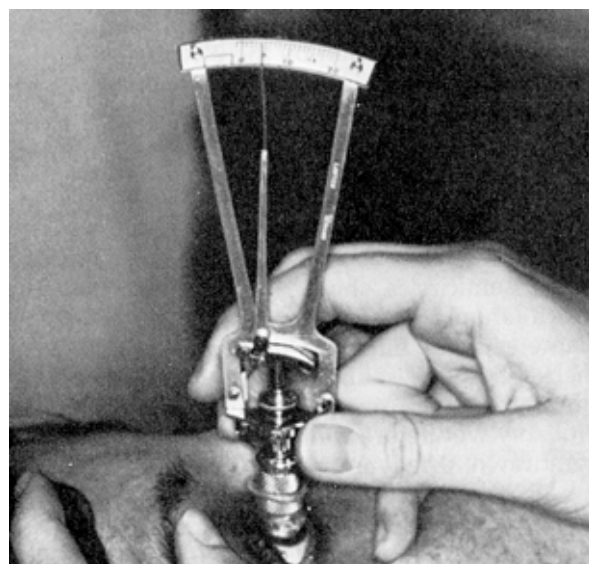
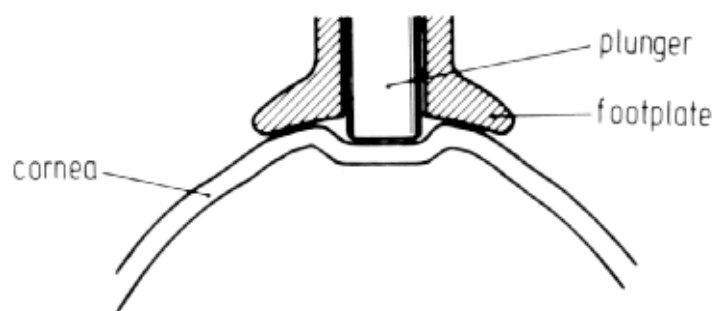
